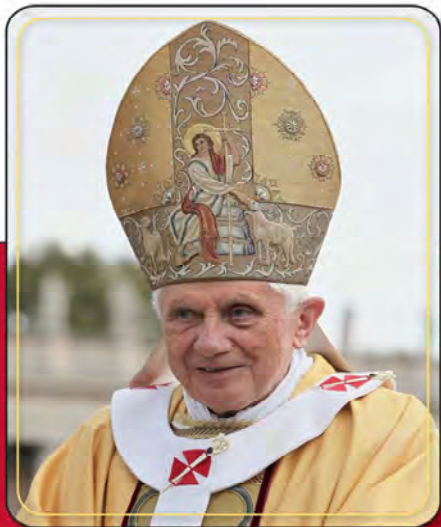

POPE EMERITUS BENEDICT XVI

IN MEMORIAM

Joseph Alois Ratzinger was born in Marktl am Inn, Bavaria, on April 16, 1927—Holy Saturday— and baptized that same day—the first person baptized in the new Easter water. It was a sign of blessing, he wrote in a memoir, that his life from the beginning was thus immerse in the Easter mystery. He entered the minor seminary in 1939 at the age of twelve, but its studies were interrupted by World War II, when the seminary was closed and Joseph, along with most of his class, was drafted into the army at the age of sixteen.

After the war he resumed his education in philosophy and theology, and together with his brother, Georg, was ordained a priest in 1951. During the course of a twenty-year career as a professor of dogma and theology at several German universities, he earned a reputation as a gifted lecturer and learned scholar, and was present as a *peritus*, or theological advisor, at all four sessions of the Second Vatican Council.

He was ordained an archbishop in May of 1977 and elevated to the College of Cardinals a month later. He settled in Rome in 1981 and went on to become one of the most influential men in the Roman curia. Of the many offices he held, he was best known as the Prefect of the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith, an authoritative advisor on doctrinal issues during his predecessor's pontificate. When he was elected the 265th successor of Peter in 2005 at the age of seventy-eight, he became the first German pope since Victor II in the eleventh century. A central theme of his papacy was the staunch defense of core Christian values against what he saw as moral decline across much of Europe. At the same time, he sought to improve relations with other religions, trying to determine if a “cultural synthesis” was possible without losing the identity of the faith while engaged in discourse with the Lutheran World Federation, Judaism, Islam, the Anglican Communion, and Christian Orthodox Churches. He also spoke out against human rights abuses and ongoing political conflicts and warfare, and advocated better protection of the environment. He called for a radical rethinking of the global economy, criticizing the growing divide between rich and poor, and pressed for a “true world political authority” to oversee the economy and work for the common good.

Ever true to his episcopal motto, “Fellow Worker in the Truth,” Pope Benedict XVI’s teaching and prolific writings always defended traditional Catholic doctrine and values.

On February 11, 2013, Pope Benedict XVI announced that on February 28, 2013, he would resign as supreme pontiff due to his advanced age and deteriorating health and that a conclave would be convened shortly thereafter to elect a new pope. He returned to Rome and remained there as Pope Emeritus after Jorge Bergoglio succeeded him as Bishop of Rome.

Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him.

In Memoriam

PAPA EMÉRITO BENEDICTO XVI

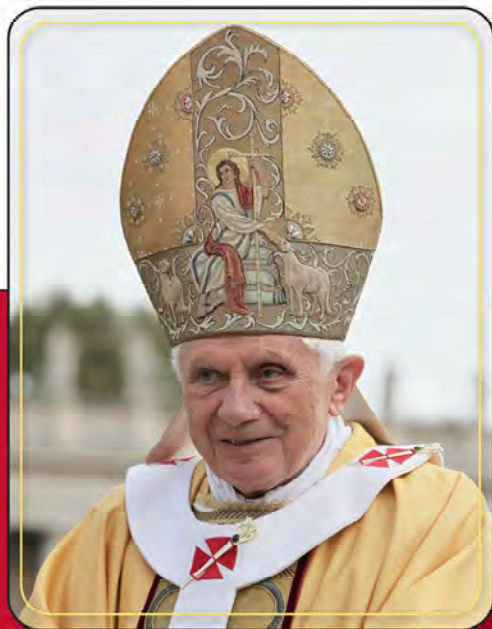
Joseph Alois Ratzinger nació en Mark am Inn, Bavaria, el 16 de abril de 1927, que coincidió ser un sábado santo; también fue bautizado ese día, la primera persona en ser bautizada en las aguas pascuales. Eso era una bendición, así lo escribió en una de sus memorias, que su vida desde el principio estuvo inmersa en el ministerio pascual. Teniendo 12 años en 1939 entró al seminario menor pero sus estudios tuvieron que interrumpirse debido a la Segunda Guerra Mundial; cuando el seminario tuvo que cerrar, cuando tenía 16 años, Joseph y casi todos sus compañeros fueron incorporados al servicio military.

Cuando la Guerra terminó, él, junto con su hermano Georg, volvieron al seminario a estudiar filosofía y teología, fue ordenado sacerdote en 1951. En un período de veinte años como profesor de dogma y teología en varias universidades alemanas, él se ganó la reputación de profesor e investigador excelente por lo que se le nombró como *perito* o consejero teólogo durante las cuatro sesiones del Concilio Vaticano II.

En mayo de 1977 lo ordenaron arzobispo y Elevado al Colegio Cardenalicio un mes después. Se mudó a Roma en 1981 llegando a ser uno de los hombres más influyentes de la curia romana. De las muchas oficinas de las que estuvo a cargo, de la que mayor se le conoció fue como el Prefecto de la Congregación para la Doctrina de la Fe, una autoridad con consejo en asuntos doctrinales durante los pontificados que le precedieron. En el 2005, cuando tenía 78 años fue elegido como el 265^{avo} sucesor de Pedro, siendo el primer papa de origen alemán desde Víctor II del sigol XI. Un tema central de su pontificado fue la fiel defensa de los valores cristianos en contra de lo que él veía como una moral en decadencia en la gran mayoría de Europa. Al mismo tiempo que continuaba buscando mejorar las relaciones con otras religions, tratando de determinar si una “síntesis cultural” era posible sin la pérdida de identidad de la fe al mismo tiempo que se comprometió en un diálogo con la Federación Mundial Luterana, el judaísmo, la communion Anglicana y las Iglesias cristianas ortodoxas. Él se pronunció en contra de los abusos de los derechos humanos y de los actuales conflictors políticos y de las guerras, se manifestó a favor de una mayor protección del medio ambiente; también convocó constantemente por un reordenamiento radical de una economí globalizada, criticando la distribución que aumenta entre ricos y pobres, presionó por una “autoridad política mundial verdadera” que vigilara la economía y el trabajo para el bien común.

Siempre fiel al lema de su escudo episcopal, el cual decía: “Trabajador de la verdad”, las enseñanzas y los escritos abundantes del papa Benedicto XVI defienden la doctrina y los valores tradicionales católicos .

El 11 de febrero de 2013, el papa Benedicto XVI anunció que renunciaría como sumo pontífice el 28 de febrero de 2013 debido a su avanzada edad y el deterioro de su salud y que un conclave sería convocado inmediatamente para elegir a un nuevo papa. Él regresó al Vaticano y vivió ahí como el Papa Emérito después que Jorge Bergolio fue elegido y lo sucedió como Obispo de Roma.

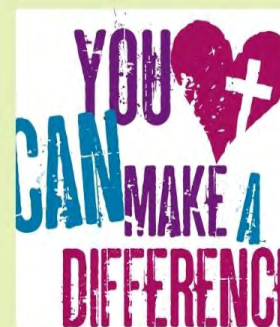

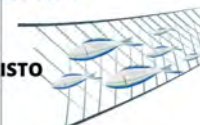

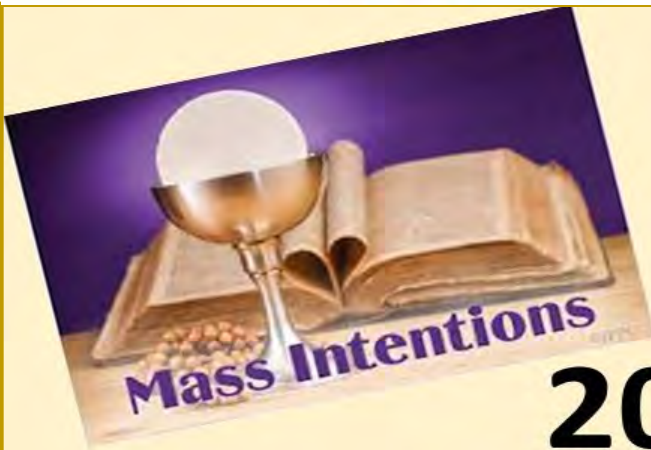
