Lenten and Triduum Regulations

The Season of Lent:

The Lenten Season of 40 days begins on Ash Wednesday. Now it is on February 22. Each year depends of the Moon Calendar, always Wednesday.

→ **Fast and abstinence** ←

Both Ash Wednesday & Good Friday,

April 7, are days of **abstinence from meat** for all Christians who are 14 years of age and older.

They are **also days of fasting** (*one full meal and two small meals, with nothing eaten between the meals*) for adults from 18 to 59 years of age.

ALL FRIDAYS OF LENT ARE DAYS OF ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT FOR THOSE 14 YEARS AND OLDER.

Liturgical notes:

1.-**Lent** runs from Ash Wednesday until the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday. 'Alleluia' is not said or sung from the beginning of Lent until the Easter Vigil, nor is the "Te Deum" sung at or on Sundays of Lent.

2.-During Lent **the altar should not be decorated** with flowers, and **musical instruments** should be used to **support the community singing** while **respecting the need for silence and reflection** during in the liturgy.

† **Stations of the Cross on Friday.** †

3.-On the **Fourth Sunday of Lent** ("Laetare" in **rose color**) and this year the Solemnity of Saint Joseph is moved to March 20th, and of the Annunciation of the Lord on Saturday March 25th, **instruments may be played**, and the altar with flowers.

4.-If marriages take place in Lent, couples are to be reminded that wedding plans should respect the special nature of this liturgical season in their simplicity.

5.-*It is recommended that during the Lenten season parishes should provide penitential celebrations that allow for the faithful to celebrate the mystery of forgiveness.* These celebrations of **forgiveness should take place before the Easter Triduum**, and should not immediately precede the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper.

The Easter Triduum:

† from **Holy Thursday** evening: Washing of the feet, Last Supper, Institution of the New Covenant and Priesthood, Agony in Mount of Olives-Getsemani,

† on **Good Friday**: Jesus' Passion, Crucifixion, Death and Burial. Adoration of the Cross.

† until evening prayer on **Easter Sunday**. Easter Vigil Celebration and Sunday of Resurrection.

Normas de Cuaresma y Triduo

La Santa Cuaresma:

El Tiempo de Cuaresma de 40 días comienza el Miércoles de Ceniza. Ahora el 22 de febrero. Cada año cambia por el Calendario Lunar, pero siempre miércoles.

→ **Ayuno y Abstinencia** ←

Ambos **Miércoles de Ceniza y Viernes Sto.**

Abril 7, son días de **abstinencia de carnes** para todo Cristiano desde los 14 años en adelante.

Son días **también de ayuno** (*una comida normal al día o dos pequeñas, con nada de comer entre horas*) para adultos de 18 años hasta los 59 de edad.

TODOS LOS VIERNES DE CUARESMA SON DÍAS DE ABSTINENCIA DE CARNE para todos.

Notas Litúrgicas:

1.-**Cuaresma** corre desde el Miércoles de Ceniza hasta la Misa de la Última Cena del Jueves Santo. 'Aleluya' no se dice ni canta desde que se inicia la Cuaresma hasta la Vigilia Pascual, no se canta el "Te Deum" estos domingos.

2.-En la Cuaresma **el altar no se decora** ni con flores, y los **instrumentos musicales sólo deberían usarse como soporte del canto comunitario, respetándose el necesario tiempo de silencio y reflexión** en la liturgia.

† **Via Crucis los viernes.** †

3.-En el **Cuarto Domingo de Cuaresma** ("Laetare", **en color rosado**) y este año la Solemnidad de san José pasa al lunes marzo 20, y la Anunciación del Señor es el sábado marzo 25, y **los instrumentos musicales pueden usarse, e incluso decorar con flores el altar.**

4.-Si algún matrimonio se celebrare en cuaresma, las parejas deberían planear la boda con mucha sencillez por respeto especial al tiempo litúrgico.

5.-*Se recomienda en cuaresma que las parroquias provean celebraciones penitenciales para permitir a los feligreses que celebren el misterio del perdón.* Deben tener lugar las celebraciones **ANTES DEL TRIDUO PASCUAL, Y NO DEBERÍAN preceder** justo a la Misa de la Última Cena del Señor

Triduo Pascual:

† desde **El Jueves Santo** por la tarde: Lavatorio de los pies, última Cena, Institución de la Nueva Alianza y Sacerdocio, y la Oración en el Huerto de Getsemani,

† el **Viernes Santo**: Pasión de Cristo, crucifixion, muerte y sepultura. Adoración de la Santa Cruz.

† **Hasta la oración de la tarde del Domingo de Pascua.** Vigilia Pascual y Misa de Resurrección.

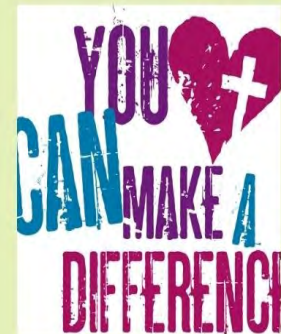
